

GENERAL FEDERATION OF WOMEN'S CLUBS – WISCONSIN  
ELECTION RULES AND PROCEDURES

1. Complimentary endorsements are not permissible.
2. There shall be no campaigning at the state convention.
3. A glossy picture (black and white) and limited article about the qualifications of each candidate will be included in the Convention issue of the *WISCONSIN CLUBWOMAN* magazine.
4. The Chairman of the GFWC-Wisconsin Nominating Committee shall present each candidate to the convention body. Each candidate shall be allowed a timed presentation (one minute).
5. The five-member Nominating Committee shall become the Election Committee at the GFWC-Wisconsin spring convention. The chairman shall designate two members as inspectors and two members as tellers. This committee shall meet for a briefing session before the start of the convention.
6. The Election Committee shall have charge of all details of election, provide the ballot boxes, canvass the vote and present the report to the convention.
7. The tellers shall provide the voter with a ballot.
8. The inspectors shall have charge of the balloting boxes.
9. Ballots and the final report of the tellers shall be sealed and delivered to the Recording Secretary who shall be the custodian of the same until the next election, when they shall be destroyed.
10. Because they must be on the platform during the convention session, the officers, parliamentarian and timekeeper are allowed special privileges. They are escorted immediately into the polling place, either at the head of the line or through the exit door.
11. The official delegate's badge **MUST** be worn for voting identification.
12. Delegates **MUST** carry their credential cards with them to the polling place. These must be properly filled out.
13. The worker at the entrance to the polling place must tell voters who are entering that there is to be **NO** talking in the voting room.
